ONE BLOCK is a non-profit, formed in response to the massive cuts to the Dept of Sanitation budget and the homelessness crisis. Our hybrid approach uses Upper West Side residents committing to clean their side streets 1 day a week, weekly group cleanups, and 2 paid workers who clean Amsterdam, Broadway, & Columbus Avenue 5 days a week.

ONE BLOCK has no government funding. Our \$12,000 monthly budget covers the salaries of our 2 ACE (Association of Community Employment Programs for the Homeless) employees & our green garbage bags.

We fill **1,000 bags of trash each week** on the Upper West Side!
The only way we can continue is through neighborhood support.

- **ONE BLOCK** co-founder, **Ann Cutbill Lenane**, will give out bags, gloves, & **ONE BLOCK** baseball hats
- Bringing your own garbage grabber is suggested
- Young children are welcome to help, but they must be carefully supervised
- Bringing your dog is not a good idea for a variety of reasons
- You will bag as much garbage as you can (not twigs or leaves) & place it next to the existing trash bins
- You will be given an assigned area to clean
